DISCRETIONARY LEARNER SUPPORT FUND

The Discretionary Learner Support Fund can offer financial help towards the cost of equipment.

You should apply at the beginning of the term in which your course starts. Funds are limited and allocated on a first come first served basis.

TRAVEL COSTS

Discount travel is available to students aged 19+ studying for 15 or more hours per week (minimum 14 weeks).

College funds for travel are paid out at the end of term, each term upon receipt of a completed claim form and subject to a satisfactory attendance report of at least 90%. Maximum travel claims for each term are £150.

16-25 rail cards cost £28 and saves you 1/3 off rail fares across Britain for one year.
