INFORMATION, ADVICE & GUIDANCE

Student Services operates a daily term time information, advice & guidance service on all main sites.

The service is mainly drop-in but confidential appointments are available and Counselling appointments can be booked.

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COUNSELLING

There may be times when it is difficult to study because it is the last thing on your mind. Counselling offers a place for you to talk through your problems with a trained professional who will listen without judging and who is experienced in dealing with difficult feelings. Having this space for yourself can help you to understand your problems better and find new ways to tackle them.

Counselling is flexible, you can come for just one session or a regular appointment. Counselling is confidential and all counsellors work to the code of ethics set by the British Association of Counselling and Psychotherapy.

Common issues brought to Counselling include:

- Relationships
- Family Issues
- Anxiety
- Depression
- Suicidal Feelings
- Sleep Problems
- Surviving Abuse
- Low Self Esteem
- Eating Problems
- Bereavement
- Drug & Alcohol misuse
